

Pansy Peach Clutch By Kathy Perry

Finished Measurements:

8" wide x 7" tall

Materials

Patons KATRINA (3 ½ oz/100 g, 163 yds/150m, 92% Rayon, 8% Polyester):

2 skeins #10510 Sherbert,

One pair size 9 (5.5mm) needles or size to obtain correct gauge,

Size F/5 (4mm) crochet hook,

Tapestry needle,

8" snap closure purse frame,

Optional: 1/4 yd fabric for lining,

Sewing needle and matching thread

Gauge

In St st (k 1 row, p 1 row), 19 sts and 28 rows = 4"/10cm

To save time, take time to check gauge.

Clutch

CO 72 sts.

Work 6 rows St st.

P 2 rows (to establish turning row for casing).

Work even in St st until piece meas 12" from turning row.

P 2 rows (to establish turning row for casing).

Work 6 rows St st.

BO loosely

Finishing

Fold casings to wrong side. Pin and whip stitch in place.

Top Lace

Work 2 rows sc on turning row of one casing. Work Rnd 2 of Picot Crochet Edge. (See instructions with Pansy Peach Camisole, in spring 2004 *Cast On*) Rep for 2nd casing.

Fold purse in half and sew side seams, stopping before casings and leaving long yarn ends.

Put purse frame bars into casings and secure with pins provided.

Finish sewing side casing edges and top lace.

Optional Lining:

Cut 2 pieces of fabric 8 1/2" wide x 8" deep. With RS tog, make 1/4" seams on sides and bottom.

Turn under top opening 1". Tack in place at bottom of casings.
