Patterns Update/Clarifications

Machrie Moor Wrap – page 11

Jaeger FUR (1.8oz/50g, 22yd/20m, 47% Wool, 47% Kid Mohair, 6% Polyamide) 11 balls 049 Antelope (Natural)

Perth Herringbone Men's Scarf – page 21

Correction: Row 2:P2tog and sl only first st off LH needle, leaving second st on needle*; rep from * to end, then work P1 in last st on needle.

Moor Stone Bolero – page 31

Back

CO 64 (72, 80) sts. Work even in Garter st for 8 (8 1/2, 8 1/2)".

Armhole Shaping: Dec 8 (8, 8)sts at the beg of next 2 rows. Cont even for 8".

Neck and Shoulder Shaping: RS, knit 12 (14, 16) sts, turn, knit across, BO.

Attach yarn to 24 (26, 32) neck sts and BO. Knit rem 12 (14, 16) for 2 rows.

BO.

Right Front

Armhole shaping: Dec 8 (8, 8) sts at beg of row. AT THE SAME TIME, dec 1 st on front edge until 12 (14, 16) sts rem. Work in Pat for 8". BO.

Aran Child's Sampler Sweater – page 38

Pattern Stitches

Rice Stitch (mult of 2 sts +1), 2 row rep

Row 1 (RS): p1, *k1, p1, rep from* to end.

Row 2: Knit

Aberdeen Silverfox Jacket & Optional Scarf/Belt – page 42

Gauge: In St st using larger needles, 130 sts and 20 rows = 4"/10cm.

Heather Lowlands Turtleneck – page 47

Back: With smaller needles, CO 114 (130, 146, 162)sts.

Beg K2 P2 Rib Pat, and work even until piece measures approx 1 1/2" from beg, ending after WS row. Change to larger needles, beg Cable Pat, and cont even until piece meas approx 14 1/2 " from beg, end after WS row.

In the Gloaming Sweater – page 51

Body Shaping: Follow pattern - maintain 1x1 Rib. After changing to larger needles, work 1 RS row in Rib. Then working 12 rows, dec 1 st ea side, work 12 rows dec 2 more sts. Change to St st and inc 1 st ea side every 12 rows – 2 times. Cont in St st even. End WS row.

Pumphries Dog Sweater – page 57

Schematic: measurement of the neck edging at the beginning should be 1 (1.5, 1.5, 2, 2) inches

Optional Pocket Instructions:

Pocket:

Cast on 15 (15, 15, 18, 18) sts. Work Stocking St for 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) ins, ending with WS facing for next row. Work in Garter St (knit every row) for 1 inch, ending with WS facing for next row. Cast off all sts. Sew pocket to side of dog coat.
